Works undertaken	<p>Works included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 1.3km DN2000 GRP pipeline▪ 2.7km DN1000 GRP pipeline▪ Installation of 13 cluster pits▪ 120ml / day pump station▪ Decommissioning / backfilling of 5kms of irrigation channel▪ Removal of 11 road crossing bridges / culverts
Highlights & Innovations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Comdain's innovation workshops developed a more cost effective solution for the client by utilising the existing pump station instead of a new one with higher capacity and constructing a smaller booster pump station midway along the pipeline.▪ Completed milestone 8 four weeks ahead of schedule with 2,000m of pipeline installed and commencement of pump station construction.
