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Comdain establishes service delivery for it's Multinet Gas Network Operations Maintenance contract

Announced in May 2012 as preferred Service Provider, Comdain Infrastructure ('Comdain') has successfully implemented it's contract mobilisation for July 1 2013 service delivery start to its Multinet Gas Network Operations and Maintenance contract. The Comdain contract team established a new depot in Clayton, procured and setup equipment, plant and vehicles, selected 70 new staff in total, qualified and engaged 30 in office functions and 40 in field functions. Required training, inductions and client network certifications and accreditation were completed and 25 subcontract service providers sourced, qualified and contracted. Enterprise Business System Interrogation between Comdain's GreenTree ERP system and Multinet's SAP system was implemented and the native (to Comdain) field data management system, ComLink rolled out.

Service delivery commenced on time on 1 July 2013 and in the past 6+ months the contract team has achieved:

- Positive feedback from the client on operational activities
- Successfully managed and closed out 2 major incidents in the first week of operations
- Successful mobilisation of capital work program - including a renewals program in Sandringham and major upgrade works in Leongatha
- ComLink has been bedded down and is supporting crews and services delivery performance
- Successful receipt, completion and uploaded of 34,000 jobs

Comdain's Capital & Maintenance Manager, John Carney said: "The team at Clayton have been very busy over the last six months, from the successful mobilisation of the contract to handling over 30,000 jobs. The standout achievement on the Multinet contract is the tremendous team culture that was prevalent from day one and how it continues to grow.
